Re: Locker Inspections & Vehicle Searches

School principals and supervisors are responsible for protecting the health, safety and welfare of the school community. Because of this, there may be a need to inspect or search lockers/vehicles.

Locker Inspections:

Any pupil's locker may be inspected at any time. During an inspection, school officials will not search garments, pocketbooks, or book and gym bags. An inspection differs from a search.

Locker/Vehicle Searches:

Sometimes there is a good reason to conduct a locker/vehicle search. A school official may search a pupils' locker/vehicle provided that the official has reasonable grounds to suspect that the search will turn up evidence that the pupil has violated or is violating either the law or the rules of the school. A school official will contact the parent or guardian regarding the search.
