Clearview Regional Community Members:

We realize there are many questions regarding the details associated with our *Reopening Plan*. As previously mentioned, we continue to respond to the changing variables as quickly as possible and we are developing a *Frequently Asked Questions* document to help provide clarity to some of the more common questions.

The purpose of tonight's communication is to provide answers to a couple questions that we've received as parents are responding to the surveys sent out over the past few days.

- Transitioning between Hybrid (In-Person and Home) and the Full-Time Remote options:
Understandably, there were concerns about the time required for students to transition from Full-Time Remote to the Hybrid or the Hybrid to Full-Time Remote. It is understood that students will experience the two learning environments in vastly different ways, so we are trying to remain student-centered and offer as much flexibility as possible when implementing each policy associated with remote learning. Here are the more salient parts of the policy that will increase your comfort level about your choice.
 - Students may begin Full-Remote learning at the beginning of the year or a week after requesting a transition from Hybrid to Full-Remote
 - There is unconditional eligibility for Full-Time Remote Learning (no medical criteria)
 - Due to the format that we're using to deliver instruction, we are able to be very flexible with the transition to and from the Hybrid and the Full-Time Remote learning environments. Students will be able to transition from one to the other within a week after the request is made to the Principal, Guidance Office, or designee. We intend to limit the transition request to one change per student. It might take a few days to modify transportation, but we believe we can respond quickly.

- Transportation waiver:
 - If you opt to sign the *Transportation Waiver Form* while we are in either a Hybrid or Full-Remote learning environment, you will be able to change your selection and choose to use the bus when we return to a 'regular' school year setting (In school all day).

Full details of the process for transitioning between learning environments in addition to other questions will be incorporated into the FAQ document.
