Dear Senior Class Members and Parents/Guardians:

The Clearview Board of Education, Administration, Class Advisors, Teachers, and Staff thank you for your continued support of Clearview Regional Schools and would like to cordially invite you to attend Graduation on June 14, 2019, **rain date June 15 at 10:00 AM**. Please be advised that all seniors must be academically eligible and in compliance with both our attendance and discipline code in order to participate in graduation. Commencement will begin 6:00 PM sharp at Riordan Field, weather permitting.

Sunday, June 9 Baccalaureate has been arranged through The Trinity United Methodist Church of Mullica Hill, located on Cedar Road beginning at 4:00 p.m. Students do not wear caps & gowns to the Baccalaureate and this event is voluntary. Please contact Pastor Ron with questions or planning at 856-478-0090.

Wednesday, June 12 Senior Awards Night will be held in the Toscano Theater for Performing Arts beginning at 6:00 PM. This night is for all students who will be receiving a graduation scholarship/award from the school and for any student receiving an outside scholarship from a college or organization. The guidance department distributed surveys to obtain this information which your son or daughter must complete in order to be recognized. All students being honored will receive an invitation prior to Senior Awards Night. (Please be aware that this ceremony does not include any grants or monies awarded for financial aid from the state or federal government). PRACTICE SCHEDULE:

All eligible seniors are **required to attend all mandatory graduation practices**. There will be no early dismissals from practice. Lateness or unexcused absences to practice will result in exclusion from graduation.

ALL academic requirements must be satisfied prior to participation in graduation practices and appropriate dress is expected during these practices.

Wednesday, June 12

Seniors must report to 1st period for locker cleanout and attendance. Students without a 1st period class should report to the theater. After completion of locker cleanout, seniors will be called to the theater where they will be placed in their walking/seating order for graduation. After practice, seniors will receive their caps and gowns.

Tickets will be distributed to all eligible students at practice on Thursday, June 13; however, students who have fines will **not** receive their tickets. **All fines must be paid before Thursday, June, 13, 2019.** Please check in the office to see if you owe a fine. Each student will receive 8 tickets for graduation that can be used for stadium seating. **Please speak to your son or daughter to determine which side of the football field they will be located (home or visitor side bleachers).**

If special needs seating tickets are requested, one general admission ticket will be exchanged for each special needs ticket. Only one adult should plan to accompany the person needing special seating. Special needs seating must be requested at least 48 hours prior to the ceremony **by emailing (McEvoyan@clearviewregional.edu).** **Please include your name, student's name, and number of special needs seats required.**

Graduate Parking

Students must park in Zone 2 (Tennis Court Lot), Zone 3 (HS Main Entrance Lot), and Zone 4 (Administration Building Lot, excluding the unnumbered spots) by **5:00 PM.** - **DO NOT BE LATE and DO NOT PARK IN THE FIRE LANES. No students will be admitted in the theater lot (reserved for special needs parking).**

Student Dress Code

- ***SUNGLASSES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BE WORN DURING THE GRADUATION CEREMONY.***
- Airbrushing of caps is permissible provided that it is tasteful, positive, and acceptable under the Clearview Regional High School Code of Dress and Conduct.
- **Male students - green cap and gown. White collared dress shirts and dark colored ties look best for pictures** (no jeans, shorts, sneakers or flip-flops).
*Students who do not have proper dress may be excluded from the ceremony.
- **Female students - gold cap and gown** (no jeans, shorts sneakers or flip-flops).
*Students who do not have proper dress may be excluded from the ceremony.

WE WOULD LIKE TO REMIND PARENTS, FAMILY, AND FRIENDS ATTENDING THE GRADUATION CEREMONY THAT THIS IS A SPECIAL CEREMONY AND WE HOPE THAT YOU WOULD DRESS ACCORDINGLY.

Spectator and Student Conduct

- SMOKING IS **NOT PERMITTED** on any part of the school grounds and you will be removed if smoking.

- As we announce the names of the Graduates, we ask that you please respect the dignity of this ceremony and honor each of the Graduates.
 - **Air horns, whistles, and other noisemakers will not be allowed into the ceremony and you may be removed if in violation.**
- Please keep bleacher aisles and walkways clear at all times during the Graduation ceremony.

- Graduation begins promptly at 6:00 PM.
- Diplomas will be distributed in the high school cafeteria following the ceremony.
- Students should proceed directly to the cafeteria after graduation (501).

Dear Senior Parents/Guardians:

Parking at the High School has been designated for the graduates and special needs guests only.

Home Side Parents: Please use the parking lot across the street by the athletic fields (entrance off of Jefferson Road between the transportation building and route 45).

Visitor Side Parents: Please use the middle school parking lot. These spots will fill up quickly. If you are unable to park there, please move to the overflow location. No parking is permitted in the fire lanes.

Overflow Parking:

If you are unable to park at the locations above or wish to use Pleasant Valley School (on Cedar Road) for your convenience, there will be three shuttle buses that will transport guests to Riordan Field at the following times:

5:10 PM
5:30 PM
5:45 PM

The shuttle bus will transport guests back to Pleasant Valley School after Graduation at the following times (pickup at the stadium):

7:45 PM
7:55 PM
8:05 PM

Handicapped or special needs individuals may park in the Toscano Theater Parking Lot. For those with limited mobility, we will have shuttles transporting directly to the stadium. **There will be absolutely NO PARKING by the stadium and in fire lanes. Additionally, the road behind the High School and Middle School, will be closed.** Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
